

## Have you joined the 2017-2018 PHS Pirate Boosters yet? If not, it is not

Joining Boosters is easy. Simply visit our website http://www.phspirateboosters.com and click on the "Membership" tab on the home screen. Once there, scroll down to fill out the membership form online and pay with your credit card or PayPal account. You may also print out a registration form and return it to Palatine High School with a check. Another option is to visit the Booster Booth at select varsity home football games to purchase your membership. Rain or shine, membership representatives are there to answer your questions.

### Membership options are as follows:

Basic Membership - \$25 - Includes a car decal, a coupon good for a one-time 20% discount at the Pirate Treasures School Store on a purchase of \$30 or more, and our online newsletters throughout the year that will keep you informed of our many activities and volunteer opportunities. Basic Membership does not include any athletic passes.

Family Membership - \$60 - Includes everything in the Basic Membership, PLUS two adult athletic passes and two child (8TH Grade and under) athletic passes.

In addition, we continue to offer adult, child, and grandparent athletic passes for purchase in an ala carte format\*\*. Athletic passes are valid for entry into all home football games (excluding IHSA playoffs) and girls' and boys' basketball games. Passes purchased through Boosters offer members the convenience of simply showing their pass at the gate and a

substantial savings over buying individual game tickets. These changes have been made in an effort for pricing consistency across all District 211 booster clubs.

District 211 students do not need a pass because they are admitted free to athletic events with a valid ID.



\*\*Please note that only one basic membership is required to purchase any amount of athletic passes and current District 211

Pirate Boosters gave \$103,000 to our PHS Community during the 2016-2017 school year! Each year, funds raised by PHS Pirate Boosters are given in the form of mini-grants to a wide variety of academic departments and extracurricular programs and services that directly impact the entire student body -

not just sports programs. Past recipients of mini-grants include: Applied Technology, Art, Athletics, Band, Commit to the Pirate, English, Family & Consumer Sciences, Halloween Trick or Treat, Media, Music, Palatine's Promise, Physical Education, Science, Social Studies and Student Services. We also award scholarships to 13 graduating seniors who personify our mission to strengthen the PHS community, as well as the Palatine community at-large. Direct donations may also be made during online registration and are greatly appreciated. Your membership is a major source of funding and critical to our success!
